

Quilters Unlimited General Membership Meeting Minutes

August 10, 2017 Meeting

The following was sent to the membership as notice of the proposed by-law change published in the July and August newsletters and via announcing at the July general membership meeting:

Notice of Proposed Change to the Guild By-Laws

Article IV – Officers

Section 2. The officers shall be elected to serve for one year. No officer may hold the same office for more than three consecutive years.

Rationale: The addition of the words “more than” reflects the original intent of the drafters of this section of the By-Laws, and conforms them to existing understanding of the Steering Committee.

This change must be voted on by the members, and may be passed if two-thirds of the members present at the meeting approve the change. Voting will take place at the August meeting.

During the business section of the August general membership meeting, President Peggy Allen read the proposed by-law change to the members present and requested a voice vote on the change.

The voice vote was unanimously in favor of the proposed by-laws change.
