## HELP THE ANIMAL SHELTER KITTIES!

All the cats at the Tallahassee-Leon Community Animal Service Center live in stainless steel kennels, which is necessary for sanitation purposes but not very comfortable.

TREATS (Treatment Resources & Education for Animals in Temporary Shelters - www.treatsinc.org) is inviting quilters to help make the cats more comfortable and show off their natural beauty to prospective adopters. By making and donating kennel quilts, you will be providing comfort to needy cats and kittens.

Since the quilts will be replaced and washed often, they will be subjected to a strong washing solution of detergent and bleach, so the kennel quilts will not last forever. But for many months they will provide the shelter kitties with a softer and warmer surface on which to lie.

## Requirements:

- Finished quilts need to be one of the following sizes:
  - Small: 22" x 28"
    Medium: 28" x 28"
    Large: 34" x 28"
    X-large: 46" x 28"
- The fabric for the quilt top as well as the backing should be 100% cotton or cotton blends. (No flannel, please)
- No tied quilts. (Cats will until them.)
- No beading, buttons, fringe, or other embellishments.
- Low-loft cotton batting should be used.
- All quilts should be machine-quilted and must have binding around the edges (this is for strength).

Quilts will be accepted at any time and will be put into the kennels immediately. This is an ongoing project to enhance the lives of the cats and kittens during their stay at the animal shelter. Any assistance you can provide will be appreciated by everyone! Thank you!
