## PILLOW CASE PIZZAZZ

Pillow case pattern by Suzanne's Quilt Shop



Pillow Case Body

(directional fabric) 1 1/4 yd. (non-directional)

Pillow Case Cuff Accent Strip

3/8 yd. 1" x 44"

3/4 yd.

1. Cut Pieces:

body - 27" x 41"

cuff - 10" x 41"

accent strip is already cut to correct size.

- 2. Press 1" accent strip in half lengthwise.
- 3. Place cuff piece face up on table.
- 4. Place accent strip on cuff and line up raw edges.
- 5. Place body of pillow case face down and line up raw edges.
- 6. Pin fabrics and baste an 1/8" seam along the edge.
- 7. Lay the pillowcase down with the right side of the cuff facing up.
- 8. Roll the body of the pillowcase up towards the middle of the cuff
- 9. Fold the cuff over the rolled body and line up the cuff edges, pin. Make sure right sides of the cuff are together and the body roll is no where near the seam.
- 10. Sew a 1/4" seam.
- 11. Pull the body out through the cuff, which will turn the cuff right side out. Press seams.
- 12. Fold the pillowcase in half, wrong sides together, with the cuff at the top.
- 13. Sew the side and bottom with a scant 1/4" seam. Trim seam to 1/8".
- 14. Turn pillowcase wrong side out, sew down the same side and bottom seams with a generous 1/4" seam to enclose the 1/8" seam.
- 15. Turn pillowcase out and press all seams.

You now have a wonderful new pillowcase. Sleep tight and pleasant dreams.
