Machine-Appliquéd Leaf Blocks

Materials (makes two blocks):

1 dark green background - 9 ½" x 9 ½"
1 light green background - 9 ½" x 9 ½"
1 light green leaf - 7" x 8"
1 light green leaf - 7" x 8"

2 pieces Lite Steam-A-Seam2 – each 7" x 8" 1 cardstock for leaf pattern– 7" x 8"

2 pieces of medium tear-away stabilizer - each 9" x 9"

- 1. Using leaf pattern on cardstock, trace leaf on one side of Lite Steam-A-Seam2 paper backing. Remove other side of paper backing and place leaf (sticky side down) on wrong side of <u>light</u> leaf fabric, pressing with fingers. Cut around leaf shape. Remove paper backing, center <u>light</u> leaf on right side of <u>dark</u> background, and press according to Steam-A-Seam directions, using pressing cloth. Leaf is now permanently attached to background. Repeat with <u>dark</u> leaf fabric and <u>light</u> background.
- 2. Pin stabilizer to back of each block. Use a blanket stitch, satin stitch, or other decorative stitch and machine stitch around outside edges of leaves using a matching or contrasting thread.
- 3. Using rotary cutter and ruler, cut leaves in half lengthwise. Carefully tear stabilizer away from back of blocks. Sew one <u>dark</u> and one <u>light</u> background together with a ¼" seam. Press seam open. Repeat with other <u>dark</u> background and <u>light</u> background. Trim each block to 8 ½" x 8 ½".

Leaf Pattern - Box measures 7" x 8"
