Valentine Hearts Tablerunner

This block can be made using a layer cake (10" precut squares) and a charm pack (5" precut squares) OR

Cut 4-5" squares of main fabric and 2-5" squares of background fabric Cut 4-2-1/2" squares of background squares

Mark a sewing line across the diagonal of all the background fabric squares.

Sew 2 of the main fabric 10" squares and 2 background 10" squares on the drawn lines.

Turn the squares around and sew 1/2" from the first sewn line. Cut between the sewing lines. The larger half square triangles are the bottom of the heart. Save the smaller half square triangles for another project.

Use the 2-1/2" background squares to snowball the tops of the remaining 5" main fabric squares. These are the top of the heart.

Sew the four squares together as a four patch.
