
# Block of the Month: Christmas in July

We're going for a holiday theme with our July block of the month. Use wintry and/or holiday scraps to make a couple (or more) of this easy nine-patch block. You will need:

Fabric A: One 2 ½" square Fabric B: Four 2 ½" squares Fabric C: Four 2 ½" squares



Using  $\frac{1}{4}$ " seams, sew your scraps together into three rows, pressing the seams in each row in the direction indicated by the arrows (below). Then sew the three rows together into a single 6  $\frac{1}{2}$ " block; press seam allowances between the rows open.



If we are unable to have a meeting in July, just hang onto your blocks (along with all those you've already made for April and May – no June block) and the next time we get together we'll select the lucky winner!
