

# Ribbon Star: May 2022 Block of the Month

This month's block is all squares and half square triangles, inspired by a block from [all people quilt dot com](http://allpeoplequilt.com). I used two 10" Kaffe Fassett layer cake print squares for "Square A" and "Square B," and Kona "Snow" for the background fabric.

Materials:

From the layer cake set or other print or solid fabrics:

- two 10" squares, contrasting but complimentary, one is Square A and the other is Square B

From the background fabric:

- one 4" width of fabric strip

Cutting instructions:

Square A and Square B

- three 4" squares each

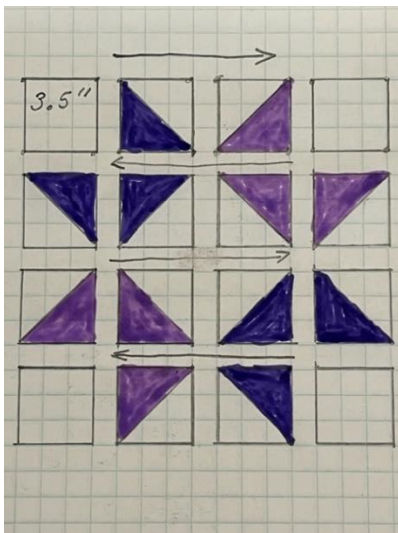
Background Fabric

- six 4" squares
- four 3.5" squares

Make twelve half square triangle blocks from the 4" background and 4" print squares. For instructions on making half square triangles you can refer to this YouTube [tutorial](#).

Trim these half square triangle blocks to 3.5" squares.

Assemble strips and press seams as shown in diagram:



Sew strips together and press seams open. Trim block to 12.5".
